A watermark is a recognizable image or pattern in paper that appears lighter when viewed by transmitted light (or darker when viewed by reflected light, atop a dark background)



Type A watermark is called the shaded watermark. A shaded watermark incorporates tonal depth and creates a grey-scale image. Instead of using a wire covering for the dandy sheet, the shaded watermark is created by areas of relief on the sheet's own surface. A watermark is very useful in the examination of parchment because it can be used for dating, identifying sizes, mill trademarks and locations, and the quality of parchment.

This embossing is transferred to the natural fibres, compressing and reducing their thickness in that area. Because the patterned portion of the page is thinner, it transmits more

light through and therefore has a lighter appearance than the surrounding paper. If these lines are distinct and parallel, and/or there is no watermak, then the parchment is termed laid parchment. This method is called "filtered"
