In Japan, astringent persimmons are used to make persimmon tannin juice, or kaki-shibu. The fruit juice is applied directly onto the washi. It has been used for preventing propagation of bacteria and water resistant. Persimmon tannin hardens the fiber of wood and paper, prevents corrosion, and makes them water resistant. It has been used to make Japanese paper, umbrellas, and wooden ware. Compared to other washi parchments, this washi is stiffer and does not allow much light to pass through.
